

## Christianity For DUMMIES

Faith Without Works
James 2:14—26

- 1. An <u>Assertion</u>: Faith Without Works Is Dead (vv. 14-17)
- James answers by pointing out the inability to <u>divorce</u> faith & works.
- James does not say that this person actually has faith, but that he <u>claims</u> to have it.

- Such faith, "profession without possession" is indeed NO GOOD.
- Words, however well meant, have not <u>profited</u> these needy people anything!
- The Greek word here for dead is "nekros" meaning "corpse."

- 2. An <u>Objection</u>: Faith & Works Are Separable (v. 18)
- Faith will <u>always</u> be accompanied by works, if it is true faith.
- Faith cannot be seen but it can only be <u>shown</u> and demonstrated by works.

- 3. A *Refutation*: Faith Without Works Is Useless (vv. 19-20)
- Not only are the demons
   monotheists, they also <u>affirmed</u> the
   Divinity of Jesus in the Gospels.
- But they have never <u>bowed</u> the <u>knee</u> to Jesus Christ and made Him Lord.
- This word foolish or shallow literally means "<u>empty</u>."

## 4. An <u>Illustration</u>: Works Show Faith

- It was not the <u>means</u> of his salvation, it was the <u>mark</u> of his salvation.
- The work a human body does doesn't give it life, the work a human body does <u>reveals</u> that life.
