The Untamable Beast James 3:1—12

- 1. A *Diffuse* Problem (vv. 1-2).
- The Greek word for "Perfect" is "teleios," meaning complete.
- The first step to control the tongue is to recognize that fact and honestly and sincerely <u>listen</u> to the words we are unleashing daily.

- 2. It's *Disproportionate* Power (vv. 3-5).
- a. Bits/Horses (v. 3).
- b. Rudder/Ships (v. 4).
- c. Tongue/body (v. 5a).
- d. Spark/fire (v. 5b).

- 3. It's *Destructive* Potential (vv. 6-8)
- The tongue is a <u>Fire</u>, which is a very appropriate analogy for the tongue.
- This reflects the four-fold order of the creation of <u>animal</u> <u>species</u> in Genesis 1.

- 4. It's *Deplorable* Propensity (vv. 9-12)
- This activity of <u>blessing</u> is cited by James as THE highest, purest, most noble form of speech.
- Like Jesus, James sees a person's speech for what it truly is...a matter of the *heart*.
