The Good, The Bad, and the Ugly James 4:13–17

1. Tomorrow: The <u>**Bad</u>** Attitude (13-14, 16)</u>

What concerns James is the basis of their attitude about tomorrow

a foolish *presumption* that summarizes their plans!

a. The *Complexity* of Life (v. 13)

Life is too complex not to factor God into our future plans!

b. The Uncertainty of Life (v. 14a): c. The *Brevity* of Life (v. 14b): Life is too brief not to factor God into our future plans!

d. The *Frailty* of Man (v. 16a)

- Man's boasting only covers up man's <u>weaknesses</u>.
- He says such arrogant boasting is <u>EVIL</u>!

Tomorrow: The <u>Good</u> Attitude (15, 17)

 The true Christian bases his or her plans not on foolish presumption but faithful <u>perspective</u>.

The will of God is "tailor-made" for each of us!

- 3. Tomorrow: The <u>UGLY</u> Attitude.
 Instead of boasting about tomorrow we should speak with <u>humility</u> and <u>submit</u> to the Lord's will.
- Sins of <u>omission</u> are just as heinous, damaging and UGLY in our lives as sins of <u>commission</u>.
