## Belonging, Believing, Becoming

#### Created to Become

Philippians 2:5

- God does not want religious <u>duty</u>, He wants a loving <u>relationship</u> with us.
- God's plan for your life has always been, to make you like Jesus Christ.
- Discipleship is the process of <u>spiritual growth</u> to make us like Jesus.

# Just like it takes years for a baby to grow to adulthood, DISCIPLESHIP IS A <u>LIFELONG</u> <u>PROCESS</u>.

## 1. GOD USES <u>TROUBLE</u> TO TEACH US TO TRUST HIM.

- God wants to use the pain of our problems to draw us <u>closer</u> to Him.
- God wants to use the troubles we face in life to build our character and faith.

- God wants to develop your character, not your <u>career</u>, to make you more Christ-like not more <u>comfortable</u>.
- Instead of asking, "Why me Lord" you should ask, "<u>What now</u> <u>Lord?</u>"
- EVERY PROBLEM HAS A <u>PURPOSE</u>.

## 2. GOD USES <u>TEMPTATION</u> TO TEACH US TO OBEY HIM.

- Temptations are situations designed by Satan intended to <u>harm</u> us and lead us into sin.
- Our own <u>EVIL DESIRE</u> is the starting place.
- God uses temptation to teach us obedience;

a. Temptation is <u>common</u> to all of us;

b. God will not let temptation *destroy* you.

c. Temptation comes with an *exit*;

- It is not a <u>sin</u> to be tempted.
- You will never <u>outgrow</u> temptation.
- Temptation brings with it a choice.

- Whatever temptation you face will uncover <u>who</u> or <u>what</u> you love the most.
- *Focus* on good thoughts.
- Get a <u>spiritual partner</u>.

#### 3. GOD USES <u>TRESPASESS</u> TO TEACH US TO FORGIVE.

- God wants to use these trespasses to teach us to <u>forgive</u>.
- Yet God used the *inhumanity* of man towards Jesus to teach us how to forgive.
- He absorbed the hurt. He put up with the pain. He responded to <u>evil</u> with <u>good</u>.

#### a. Remember God has forgiven us.

- b. Remember God is still <u>in</u> <u>control</u>.
- You may not see what God is doing yet, but <u>trust</u> Him.
- God won't leave the work He has started in you unfinished...He will <u>complete</u> it.
