

The Road of Discovery

Luke 24:13--35

1. Concealment-

We can come to Him just as we are, without putting on any <u>mask</u> of formality.

2. Conversation-

- Counseling experts often underscore the importance of asking *questions*.
- Good communication is as much about *listening* as it is about *talking*.

3. Confusion-

- His first coming was all for the purpose of reigning in the throne of *man's heart* rather than from an earthly throne in Jerusalem.
- 4. *Canon* exposition-
- Because it came from the <u>Writer</u> of the Bible itself (II Tim 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21).

5. Conviction-

- As Christ quoted the Bible, His words warmed their hearts.
- Scriptures are Divinely inspired, so they make our *words* authoritative.
- It is one thing to have the Scriptures in hand and quite a different thing to handle them <u>properly</u>.
- He has promised to place both His <u>Word</u> and His <u>Spirit</u> within us.

6. Communion-

- He is not a <u>gate-crashing</u> God.
- He ensured a level playing field by providing a <u>free choice</u> of obedience to our First parents in the Garden of Eden.
- Is it not the unchanging Christ bringing us together for a time of common *fellowship* in HIM (Gal 3:28)?

7. Commission-

- Though there was no verbal instruction from the Master to be a witness to His resurrection, they felt <u>compelled</u> in their spirits to go back to to Jerusalem.
- Sharing the Good News (GOSPEL) is an exercise which comes only after fully experiencing and enjoying its <u>redemptive</u> power.
