**Reasons For Confidence** II Thessalonians 2:13–3:5 1. Our Salvation depends on God • From God's perspective, He <u>chose</u> us before He made us.

<u>Salvation</u> is God's work, not our work.

2. Our <u>Progress</u> depends on God
To "stand fast" means "<u>brace</u>
<u>yourself</u>".

## While our feet dig <u>in</u>, our hands hold <u>on</u>.

• "Standing firm" and "holding on" sound very *active*, very energetic, far from passive resignation.

3. Our Effectiveness depends on God • The words "spread rapidly" conjure up the image of a marathon runner who sets a *pace* so he or she completes the race.

•The message is honored when people receive it as their <u>own</u>.

•We can count on God to be God, to protect us and guard us, to shield us from <u>assaults</u> on our soul.

### •We labor, but **God** is the one who **builds**.

### "Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain."

# 4. Our <u>Ability</u> to <u>Obey</u> depends on God

•Obedience is an issue of the *heart*.

•Obedience is a matter of our willing, of our <u>choosing</u> God's way instead of our own way or our culture's way. • In a similar way, we are responsible to obey, but God is the one who supplies the *power* to do it.

•This keeps us <u>God</u>-focused instead of <u>human</u>-focused, it keeps our ministry <u>God</u>-centered instead of <u>church</u>-centered.
