## The Confidence of True Worship

1. God's purpose for what He is telling Moses to do is to establish *intimacy* with His people.

- In the natural, people are simply not equipped to walk into the holy presence of God.
- The goal of worship is God <u>dwelling</u> with us.

- Notice the importance of doing it <u>God's way</u> (Ex. 25:9).
- His way is the <u>only way</u> it will work.
- Now please understand, this was only a type, a figure, a picture of the <u>real thing</u>.

 So as we approach God we are to continually allow the word of God to identify things in our lives that need to be <u>washed</u>.

- We should see them as *provisions* God has made for us so that we can come into His presence.
  So, the cherubim represent a
  - heavenly <u>reality</u>.

- The Ark represents the *character* of God.
- His mercy is expressed to all who <u>willingly</u> come under the headship of Christ.

- Everything we have said leads us to this place where God <u>meets</u> with His people.
- The basic meaning of the Hebrew word (kappor'eth) in Ex. 25:17 translated mercy seat is simply <u>covering</u>.

- 2. Practical <u>Application</u> to Our Corporate Worship
- We must come into God's presence in absolute <u>reliance</u> upon Christ's finished work on our behalf.

- Our confidence is found in what Jesus has <u>already done</u> for us.
- God does not meet with us on the basis of our good <u>behavior</u>.

- But our *performance* is not the basis of our *boldness* before God.
- The answer is <u>Meeting God</u> at the Mercy Seat.
- He meets with us on the basis of the *atonement*.
