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The High Calling of God The concept and purpose of a divine call is not something we create, it is something God places within us.

 A strong inner impulse toward a particular course of action especially when accompanied by conviction of <u>divine influence</u>.

 Often we use our imperfections as an <u>excuse</u> for us to not serve or honor God in the way he has called us.

· God uses a miracle to ensure Jonah would go to where God wanted him to be. Often God's call was not comfortable or convenient for

them.

 All of us who are called by God have a *responsibility* to do His work and build the church, which is the body of Christ. • For Paul, calling was not a final destination it was a journey.

 The Bible uses the words 'Call' and 'Calling' in different theological ways, the words are used in connection with appointment.

 Every Christian is called by God for a <u>specific purpose</u>.

1. The Call to Salvation: The Call to Salvation is a call that is made to every person in the world. It is the call to accept the sacrifice of Jesus as *full payment* for our sin.

## 2. The Call to <u>Sanctification</u>

•The word "sanctify" means to <u>set</u> <u>apart</u>.

•The Call to Sanctification is a call to live a changed life, a new-life, a born-again life, a <u>Spirit</u>-<u>filled</u> life.

## 3. The Call to Service

 And we are called to service to <u>demonstrate</u> His love. a. All of these calls come from God. b. God has given you free will to choose how you will respond to each of these calls. c. The third thing about these calls is they are all urgent.

## Choosing not to make a choice is actually choosing to <u>reject</u> God's

call.
