- Faith is the connection to the bigger world.
- It is the intersection between the *finite* and *infinite*.
- There are things <u>unseen</u> that we have reason to believe in.

• It is so important to understand that faith is not about that which is irrational, it is about that which is <u>beyond</u> finite understanding.

Faith is essential to responding to God's saving love.

The point here is about

- Faith is what God <u>seeks</u> to find at work in us.
- Faith is seeing the <u>bigger reality</u> of God's purposes and power.
- Faith is <u>seeing</u> that there is more at work in any given situation.

- The word heart in the Hebrew culture speaks of one's whole inner <u>disposition</u>.
- There is an unseen realm in the world that's <u>more</u> <u>real</u> than the seen realm.

- 1. How Fear *shapes* what is ahead of us.
- a. Fear *exaggerates* our problems.

- Fear will exaggerate the obstacle you face and the *limitations* you have.
- When you look at your problems with eyes of fear, they get <u>bigger</u>.

- b._Fear spreads

 discouragement...in us and around us.
- •That is the essence of what discouragement is, it <u>steals</u> courage.

- c. Fear can lead to complaining, blaming, and becoming enslaved to familiarity.
- This reference to how the people looked back to Egypt has often been noted as one of the most fascinating reflections of how deceiving our perspectives can become.

• The truth is that we find comfort in what is familiar.
