- God is still speaking and God wants you <u>hear</u> Him to <u>know</u> His voice.
- You have to be *tuned in*.
- And not just hearing the voice of God but <u>understanding</u> what He's saying to us.

- A ZOE life is life to the maximum.
- If you want to know the voice of God, you've got to understand <u>who</u>
