Hebrews 11; Colossians 2:7

 "Faith is trusting in the larger reality of God's purposes and power. It's not avoiding what is at hand...it is daring to seek the larger God-inspired potential...the intersection between the finite and infinite...and stepping into it."

- 1. We will grow <u>beyond</u> the <u>bounds</u> of the familiar.
- But one can never <u>expand</u> unless we explore what is not familiar.
- Faith is spelled R-I-S-K.

- 2. We will grow <u>deeper</u> in <u>power</u> to endure hardship.
- When we are growing in our connection to the bigger reality of God, we develop a stronger, more centered life.

- 3. We will grow in our <u>connection</u> with others.
- Their root systems are intertwined.
- All the trees support and *protect* each other.

- 4. We will grow in gaining God's vision for our lives.
- •God wants to establish a stronger sense of HIS <u>purpose</u> for you.

- 5. We will grow in fulfilling our common calling.
- When we join in fulfilling something <u>bigger</u> than <u>ourselves</u> we are able to accomplish what we could never accomplish alone.

 What we see is the process by which we <u>experience</u> God's working.

- a. Focus on serving God's *purposes*.
- •As John makes so clear, this was a <u>sign</u> not a <u>show</u>.
- •It was about people recognizing something *greater*.

- b. *Recognize* what I cannot control or accomplish in myself.
- We need to recognize that there is an <u>opportunity</u> in a problem I cannot solve.

- c. Trust God by <u>giving</u> Him what I have.
- It's more like investing in something <u>certain</u>.

 God created us as those who bear His image and serve as *partners* in working with creation.
