# KINGDOM OF GOD IS NEAR

MORE THAN HEAVEN, MORE THAN THE CHURCH

 We call these books "gospels" because they contain the good news about Jesus.

 The good news is the proclamation that God's Kingdom has come <u>near</u> to people.

 When we take the Lordship of Christ seriously, God's <u>will</u> is done God's <u>way</u>, among God's <u>people</u>.

 He talks about the Kingdom <u>eight</u> <u>times</u> in his sermon!

 Jesus is telling us that God's Kingdom is not a <u>physical</u> kingdom.

 Part of the good news from Jesus is that it is possible to live here, on earth, in peace and harmony, free from <u>fear</u> or <u>anxiety</u>.

 The reality of God's Kingdom should first be demonstrated among <u>God's</u> <u>people</u>.

 Jesus is instructing his followers to pray that God's Kingdom would become an everyday <u>reality</u> in their everyday lives.

- God's Kingdom should be our highest priority.
- The new birth is the <u>entryway</u> into God's Kingdom.
- We cannot live fully as subjects of King Jesus apart from His <u>grace</u> and <u>mercy</u>, apart from His Spirit living in us.

1. The Kingdom of God is more than *Heaven*.

- We should not <u>confuse</u> the Kingdom of God with heaven.
- The Kingdom of God is where the <u>KING</u> has <u>dominion</u>.

2. The Kingdom of God is not the same thing as the *church*.

 This means that we can discover the Kingdom of God in some <u>surprising</u> places!

- Daniel's life and ministry was an outpost of God's Kingdom.
- You can find God's Kingdom in <u>unusual</u> places.
- You will find the presence of the King in the <u>hearts</u> of his people.
