LEARNING KINGDOM VALUES

 No one attains, earns, or works for their place in God's Kingdom– –we are born into it.

 God's Kingdom doesn't <u>operate</u> in the ways that worldly kingdoms do.

 The <u>values</u> of God's Kingdom are radically different.

 The Kingdom of God is the true context for <u>discipleship</u>.

- In His absence, Jesus expects us to <u>demonstrate</u> and <u>explain</u>
   God's Kingdom today.
- In our enthusiasm over God's forgiveness and mercy, we have <u>overlooked</u> His purposes and plans.

 When we are focused on God's Kingdom, we find ourselves immersed in <u>His priorities</u>.

 We must <u>learn</u> the <u>ways</u> of God's Kingdom.

 We are trying to live our lives by the <u>values</u> of the world's kingdom.

 As children of the kingdom, we have an <u>inheritance</u> from God.

- Notice the difference between "dominion of <u>darkness</u>" and the "kingdom of <u>light</u>."
- Wouldn't it be awful to have a grand inheritance of children of the light, but still <u>choose</u> to live life as though we were in darkness?

 The task of discipleship is the work of learning a new way to live, turning Kingdom values into practical <u>actions</u>.

 They will see the light if we live like we are <u>in</u> the light!
