 "What sort of service toward God and toward others am I <u>called to</u>?"

• Ministry simply means using the gifts and talents God has given us, and helping someone else with them in the name of God.

So we are all called to be not only servants, but also ministers.

And so if we were called to <u>salvation</u>, we were called to to <u>serve</u>.

1. We Were <u>Created</u> for Service.

Building God's House God created us so that we can serve Him and His kingdom

purposes.

• We have been <u>designed</u> and <u>molded</u> by God to make a contribution in life.

2. We Are Saved for Service. Paul tells Timothy to rekindle the gift that God had given to him. Paul then reminds Timothy that He was saved for a holy work.

 The answer is because He has something for us to do. • We are merely servants of God, saved and called by God to do His good pleasure, to do His kingdom work.

3. We Are Gifted for Service. The Apostle Paul tells us that these gifts are the outworking of the Holy Spirit in our lives to benefit the church, which is, the body of Christ.

 The Apostle Paul tells us to start working together with our gifts as a fully *functioning* body.

Tips for Service

a. Forget <u>Yourself</u>. Building God's House be <u>others-oriented</u>.

b. Don't Wait. Don't wait for perfect conditions. Building God's House

c. Get Rightly *Focused*.
One of the major barriers to serving is that of wrong *motivations*.

d. Be Faithful.
